
Explanation of Session Codes



The first letter of the code designates the meeting. The second element denotes the day of the week. The third element indicates the session series in that day (for instance, 1 would denote the first sessions in that day). Each day begins with the letter A in the fourth element and continues alphabetically through the parallel session. The lettering then restarts with each new series. The number on the end of the code (separated from the session code with a period) signals the position of the talk within the session (first, second, third, etc.). For example, a presentation coded WW2B.4 indicates that this paper is being presented as part of the HILAS meeting on Wednesday(W) in the second series of sessions (2), and is the second parallel session (B) in that series and the fourth paper (4) presented in that session.
